FINDINGS:

- (1) On May 25, 1989, Mr. Jack Fishburn contacted the Division of Oil and Gas regarding the Fishburn #1 well.
- (2) Mr. Fishburn stated that the injection tubing pressure and the tubing-casing annulus pressure were equalizing.
- (3) The condition stated in paragraph two indicates that either the tubing or packer has lost mechanical integrity.
- (4) The above-stated conditions present an imminent danger to public health or safety or are likely to result in immediate substantial damage to natural resources.

ORDERS:

- (5) It is hereby ORDERED that Walter and Karen Fishburn immediately cease all operations at the Fishburn #1 well.

**ORDERS:**


- (5) It is hereby **ORDERED** that Fishburn Services, Inc. immediately cease all operations at the Fishburn No. 1 well.

- (7) If Fishburn Services, Inc. chooses not to repair the Fishburn No. 1 well, the well shall be plugged within ninety (90) days after receipt of this Order.
- (8) Fishburn Services, Inc. shall contact the UIC Section at (614) 265-6926 to have a Division representative present to witness the work outlined above.

SUBJECT: AMENDED INJECTION PRESSURE

The Chief of the Division of Oil and Gas ("Division") having given due consideration to the matter contained herein makes the following Findings and issues the following Orders:

FINDINGS

- (1) On March 24, 1981, Walter and Karen Fishburn ("Fishburn") were granted permission to inject brine at the above-referenced well at a maximum injection pressure of 1100 psi.
- (2) On September 13, 1988, a mechanical integrity test was successfully performed at the referenced well. This test was conducted at a pressure of 1085 psi.
- (3) Section 1501:9-3 of the Ohio Administrative Code requires that mechanical integrity be demonstrated at the maximum allowable injection pressure.
- (4) Fishburn has decided to forego testing at the permitted pressure of 1100 psi and accept a maximum injection pressure of 1085 psi.

ORDERS

- (1) The maximum allowable injection pressure for Permit No. 3388, Fishburn Well No. 1, SWIW #45, Bennington Township, Morrow County, shall be 1085 psi.
- (2) Operational Stipulation, Item 1 shall be amended to read as follows: 1) Surface injection pressure must not exceed 1085 psi.
- (3) Fishburn may request and receive an increase in the maximum allowable pressure to 1100 psi upon the successful demonstration of mechanical integrity of that pressure.
