ORDER BY THE CHIEF

Morrow County, Lincoln Township

SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF INJECTION OPERATIONS

The Chief of the Division of Mineral Resources Management ("Division") having given due consideration to the matter contained herein makes the following Findings and issues the following Orders:

FINDINGS:

- (1) On July 26, 2000, the Division conducted an inspection at the Power (Fegley) No. 1 wellsite.
- (2) This inspection revealed that the injection tubing pressure and the tubing-casing annulus pressure were equalizing.
- (3) The condition stated in Paragraph Two indicates that either the tubing or packer has lost mechanical integrity.
- (4) The above stated condition presents an imminent danger to public health or safety or is likely to result in immediate substantial damage to natural resources.

ORDERS:

- (5) It is hereby **ORDERED** that Fishburn Services, Inc. immediately cease all operations at the Power (Fegley) No. 1 well.
- (6) Prior to resuming injection operations, Fishburn Services shall take the following measures with respect to the Power (Fegley) No. 1 well.

- (a) Within ten (10) days after receipt of this Order, submit a written plan to the Division for repairing and testing the Power (Fegley) No. 1 well pursuant to Section 1501:9-3-07(H), O.A.C.
 - (b) Within forty-five (45) days after the Division's approval of the written plan for the Power (Fegley) No. 1 well, perform the repair work and test the well for mechanical integrity with a Division representative present.
- (7) If Fishburn Services, Inc. chooses not to repair the Power (Fegley) No. 1 well, the well shall be plugged within ninety (90) days after receipt of this Order.
- (8) Fishburn Services, Inc. shall contact the UIC Section at (614) 265-6926 to have a Division representative present to witness the work outlined above.

SUBJECT: Suspension of Injection Operations

The Chief of the Division of Oil and Gas ("Division") having given due consideration to the matter contained herein makes the following Findings and issues the following Orders:

FINDINGS:

- (1) On September 25, 1990, Fishburn Services, Inc. tested the mechanical integrity of the Power #1 well.
- (2) Fishburn Services, Inc. was unable to demonstrate the mechanical integrity of the Power #1 well.
- (3) The condition stated in paragraph two indicates that either the tubing or packer has lost mechanical integrity.
- (4) The above-stated conditions present an imminent danger to public health or safety or are likely to result in immediate substantial damage to natural resources.

ORDERS:

- (5) It is hereby **ORDERED** that Fishburn Services, Inc. immediately cease all operations at the Power #1 well.
- (6) Prior to resuming injection operations, Fishburn Services, Inc. shall take the following measures with respect to the Power #1 well:
 - (a) Within ten (10) days after receipt of this Order, submit a written plan to the Division for repairing and testing the Power #1 well pursuant to Section 1501:9-3-07(H), O.A.C.

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- (b) Within forty-five (45) days after the Division's approval of the written plan for the Power #1 well, perform the repair work and test the well for mechanical integrity under the supervision of a Division representative.
- (7) If Fishburn Services, Inc. chooses not to repair the Power #1 well, the well shall be plugged within ninety (90) days after receipt of this Order.
- (8) Fishburn Services, Inc. shall contact the UIC Section at (614) 265-6926 to have a Division representative present to supervise the work outlined above.
