SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF INJECTION OPERATIONS

The Chief of the Division of Oil and Gas ("Division") having given due consideration to the matter contained herein makes the following Findings and issues the following Orders:

FINDINGS:

- (1) On May 30, 1997, the Division conducted an inspection at the No. 2 Tretow wellsite.
- (2) This inspection revealed that the injection tubing pressure and the tubing-casing annulus pressure were equalizing.
- (3) The condition stated in Paragraph Two indicates that either the tubing or packer has lost mechanical integrity.
- (4) The above stated condition presents an imminent danger to public health or safety or is likely to result in immediate substantial damage to natural resources.

ORDERS:


- (5) It is hereby ORDERED that Joseph M. Murnane immediately cease all operations at the No. 2 Tretow well.
- (6) Prior to resuming injection operations, Joseph M. Murnane shall take the following measures with respect to the No. 2 Tretow well.
 - (a) Within ten (10) days after receipt of this Order, submit a written plan to the Division for repairing and testing the No. 2 Tretow well pursuant to Section 1501:9-3-07(H), O.A.C.

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- (b) Within forty-five (45) days after the Division's approval of the written plan for the No. 2 Tretow well, perform the repair work and test the well for mechanical integrity with a Division representative present.
- (7) If Joseph M. Murnane chooses not to repair the No. 2 Tretow well, the well shall be plugged within ninety (90) days after receipt of this Order.
- (8) Joseph M. Murnane shall contact the UIC Section at (614) 265-6926 to have a Division representative present to witness the work outlined above.



SUBJECT: Suspension of Injection Operations

The Chief of the Division of Oil and Gas ("Division") having given due consideration to the matter contained herein makes the following Findings and issues the following Orders:

FINDINGS:

- (1) On December 4, 1989, Mr. Al Ratliff notified the Division that the tubing-casing annulus on the Tretow No. 2 well would not hold pressure.
- (2) The condition stated in paragraph one indicates that either the tubing or packer has lost mechanical integrity.
- (3) The above-stated conditions present an imminent danger to public health or safety or are likely to result in immediate substantial damage to natural resources.

ORDERS:

- (4) It is hereby **ORDERED** that Dalton & Hanna Co. immediately cease all operations at the Tretow No. 2 well.
- (5) Prior to resuming injection operations, Dalton & Hanna Co. shall take the following measures with respect to the Tretow No. 2 well:
 - (a) Within ten (10) days after receipt of this Order, submit a written plan to the Division for repairing and testing the Tretow No. 2 well pursuant to Section 1501:9-3-07(H), O.A.C.

- (b) Within forty-five (45) days after the Division's approval of the written plan for the Tretow No. 2 well, perform the repair work and test the well for mechanical integrity under the supervision of a Division representative.
- (6) If Dalton & Hanna Co. chooses not to repair the Tretow No. 2 well, the well shall be plugged within ninety (90) days after receipt of this Order.
- (7) Dalton & Hanna Co. shall contact the UIC Section at (614) 265-6926 to have a Division representative present to supervise the work outlined above.
